We will operate vibrant hydroaquaponics labs that will provide fruits, vegetables and herbs to our culinary arts program, and to food insecure families and community members.




We will maintain a living laboratory designed as a model estuaryof the Hudson River for the purpose of hands-on environmental learning and research.

We will submit updated long range facilities plans to the NJ Department of Education.




We will conduct thorough demographic studies to measure the amount of enrollment growth in our schools.
